

Have you ever needed a storage box to organize all of your personal belongings in one container? Have you ever needed to make your own personal storage box that could be used to keep all of your material packed away in one container without having to go through many different storage devices to find what you were looking for? Then look through these instructions on how to make a storage device that can accurately store all of your belongings in one container without having a disorganized array of items.

Items Needed:

- 1/8 inch plywood sheets
- Hinges
- Hot Glue Gun
- cloth/fabric
- Velcro
- screwdriver
- nails

Directions:

- 1.) Take 4 pieces of plywood and cut it to where they all measure 13 inches on all four sides of the piece of wood.
- 2.) Now take a piece of wood and cut 6 pieces of wood that all measure 3" X 6.5" and set all of these pieces of wood aside in a pile.
- 3.) Then cut 4 pieces of wood that all measure 3" x 13" and set these all aside.
- 4.) Now cut 2 pieces of wood that is 6.5" x 13"
- 5.) Take the four 13"x13" pieces of wood and use hot glue to glue each of the sides of the wood to each other so that they make a cube like box without the top part being added to it.
- 6.) Now take the two 3"x13" pieces of wood and attach the 3"x6.5" pieces of wood to both sides with hot glue and then attach the bottom piece(6.5" x 13") with hot glue as well.
- 7.) Do the same thing with the other to 3"x 13" pieces of wood.
- 8.) Now that one has this box like structure completed, take the two last 3"x6.5" pieces and measure off 6,5" length wise from the 13" length boards and place these pieces of wood with glue there. This acts as a sort of divider for the storage box.
- 9.) After that is done. Cut 4 pieces of 3" by 6.5" cloth to cover the bottom of each of the individual storage compartments and attach theses cloths with Velcro to all four sides of each compartment so as to insure that the items do not fall

- 10.) Now take these two longer boxes and carefully attach 3 hinges to the left side of one box and the right side of the other box.
- 11.) Carefully drill these same hinges to the 13"x13" box that was previously made and the storage box is finally finished.
- 12.) Now one can paint or decorate this box however they may wish.
- 13.) One may also like to provide a divider in the middle of the 13" x 13" box. To do this, cut another piece of 13" x 13" wood and attach the sides to the box with hot glue.

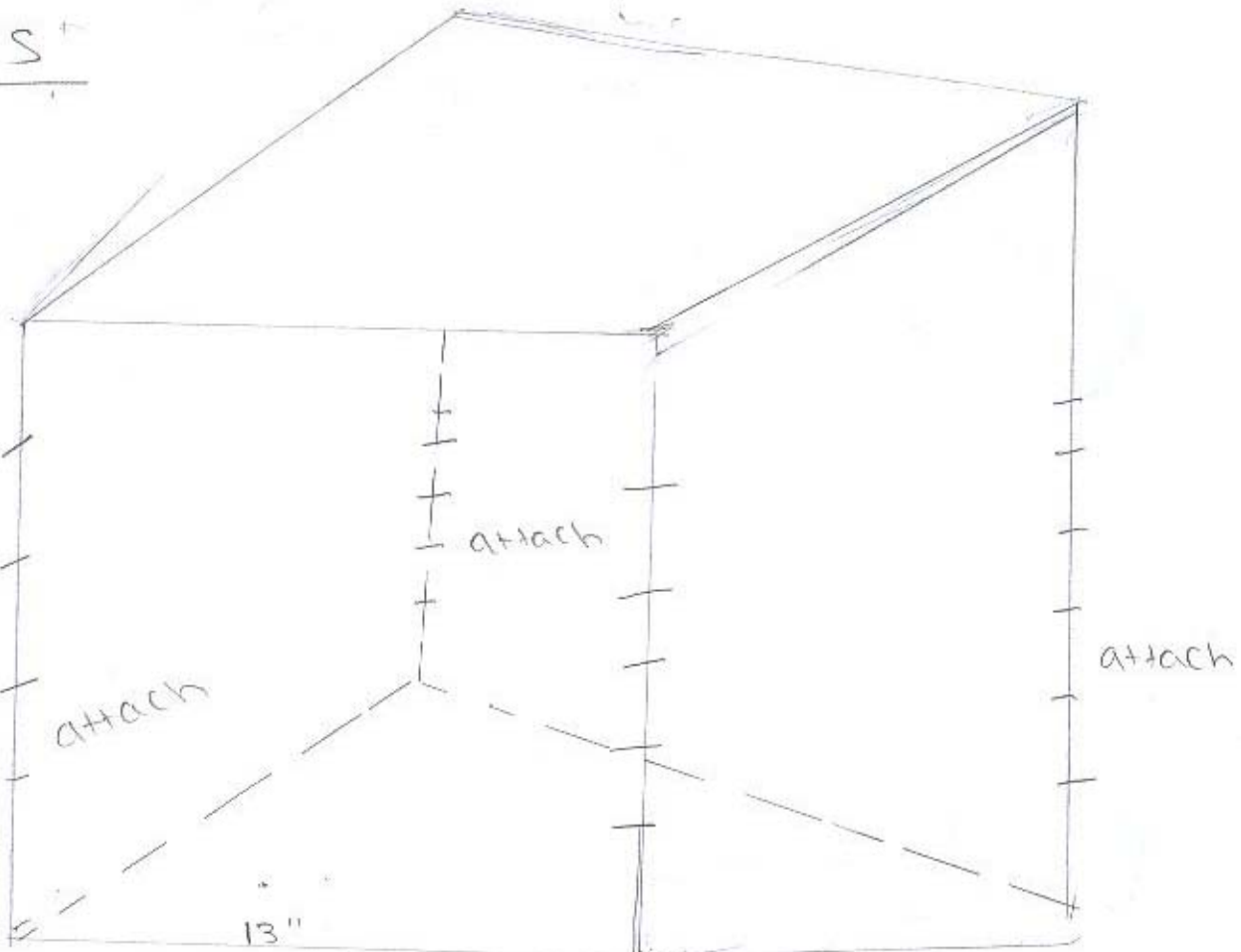
