

### Application Option 1

Wondering what to do with your old floppy disks? No one uses these old disks anymore and yet many people still have them lying around their home. Well now you can transform them into trendy, recycled coin banks. All you have to do is follow these simple directions!

- 1.) Take 6 floppy disks of equal size.
- 2.) Open the floppy disk you choose to be the top of your box and remove the stuff inside.
- 3.) With the disk separated into two pieces, cut a rectangle of equal size in the same location on each side of the disk. Make this rectangle large enough to fit a quarter through.
- 4.) Put the disk back together and make sure your rectangular holes line up, set this disk aside.
- 5.) Now lay one of the disks down in front of you. Take another disk and put hot glue on one of its edges. Glue that edge to the disk in front of you so that it forms a right angle with the other disk.
- 6.) Take another floppy disk and put glue on two of its edges so that you can glue it to the disk that is set down flat and the edge of the other disk.
- 7.) Repeat this process until you have a disk with four walls.
- 8.) Now take the disk with the hole in it and glue all four sides and close the cube.
- 9.) When the glue dries you should have a cube made from floppy disks that can be used as a coin bank!
